I hereby declare, on oath, that I absolutely and entirely renounce and abjure all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to *EDWARD VII KING OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN & IRELAND* of which I have heretofore been a *subject* (and that I further renounce the title of *subject*); that I will support and defend the Constitution and laws of the United States of America against all enemies, foreign and domestic, and that I will bear true faith and allegiance to the same.

ORDER OF COURT ADMITTING PETITIONER

Upon consideration of the petition of *Patrick Joseph Byrne*, and affidavits in support thereof, and further testimony taken in open Court, it is ordered that the said petitioner who has taken the oath required by law, do, and hereby is, admitted to become a citizen of the United States of America, this *14* day of *June*, A. D. 19*09*

It is further ordered, upon consideration of the petition of the said *Patrick Joseph Byrne*, that his name be, and he is, changed to *Patrick Joseph Byrne* under authority of the provisions of section 8 of an act entitled "An Act to establish a Bureau of Immigration and Naturalization, and to provide for a uniform rule for the naturalization of aliens throughout the United States," approved June 29, 1906.
