That said deceased departed this life at the County of Kings, on the tenth  
day of September 1912, and was at or immediately previous to his death  
a resident of the County of Kings.

That your petitioner has made diligent search and inquiry for a will of said deceased and has  
not found any, or obtained any information that he left any; and, therefore, alleges, upon information  
and belief, that said deceased died without leaving any last Will and Testament.

That said deceased died a natural death and that your Petitioner saw the remains of said  
deceased after his death.

That said deceased at the time of his death was possessed and the owner of certain personal  
property, the value of which does not exceed the sum of  
ONE THOUSAND (\$1000.00) Dollars,

That said deceased at the time of his death was seized of real estate, the
