WS(NYA) PETITION FOR NATURALIZATION

To the Honorable the U.S. District Court of Southern District of New York, NY

The petition of Sarah Garbus, hereby filed, respectfully sheweth:

(1) My place of residence is 741 Crotona Park North, Bronx, N.Y. My occupation is Housewife

(2) I was born to Pinak, Poland on December 15, 1883. My race is Hebrew

(3) I am married. The name of my HUSBAND is Jacob Pinak, Poland

born at Pinak, Poland on August 14, 1878

at New York, N.Y. on May 1906 for permanent residence therein, and now resides at 741 Crotona Park North, Bronx, N.Y. I have 4 children, and the names, date, and place of birth, and place of residence of each of said children are as follows:

Rose, Mar. 8, 1904; Adele, Dec. 15, 1906; both born in Poland, Adele, Sept. 5, 1911;

Rosamel, Aug. 15, 1916; both born in New York, N.Y. and residing with me.

Rose resides in Spring Valley, N.Y. and Adele in Bronx, N.Y.

My husband was naturalized on January 12, 1928 at New York, N.Y. certificate No. 2698130

(4) My last foreign residence was Pinak, Poland. My legal entry for permanent residence in the United States was at New York, N.Y. under the name of Rose Garbus on September 10, 1906 on the vessel SS Grodno

as shown by the certificate of my arrival hereto.

(5) I am not a disbeliever in or support to organized government or a member of or affiliated with any organization or body of persons teaching doctrine in or opposed to organized government. I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy. I am attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States and well disposed to the good order and happiness of the United States. It is my intention to become a citizen of the United States and to renounce absolutely and forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to

The Republic of Poland and (or) The Union of Soviet Socialist Republics

of whom (which) at this time I am a subject (or citizen), and it is my intention to reside permanently in the United States. (6) I am able to speak the English language.

(7) I have resided continuously in the United States of America for the term of years at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since September 10, 1906 and in the County of Bronx, New York.

This State, continuously next preceding the date of this petition, since September 1, 1915 and in the County of Bronx, New York.

My husband was naturalized on January 12, 1928 at New York, N.Y. certificate No. 2698130

(8) I have not heretofore made petition for Naturalization; Number and each petition was denied by that Court for the following reasons and causes, to wit:
