No. PETITION FOR NATURALIZATION  
U. S. District Court of Southern District of New York N. Y.

To the Honorable the Court of Southern District of New York N. Y.  
The petition of SARAH GARBUS, hereby filed, respectfully shows:  
(1) My place of residence is 895 Beck Street, Bronx, NY. My occupation is housewife.  
(2) I was born in Minsk, Poland, on December 1876. My race is Hebrew.  
(3) I declared my intention to become a citizen of the United States on May 14, 1936, in the U. S. District Court of Southern Dist. at New York, NY.  
(4) I am married. The name of my husband is Joseph. I have 6 children, and the name, date, and place of birth, and place of residence of each of said children are as follows: Kitty, Dec. 1887, Morton, Dec. 1889, both born in Poland, Sam, July 6, 1903, Anna, March 21, 1905, Rose, Nov. 21, 1908, Charles, Feb. 28, 1912. All born in New Jersey. All reside at Bronx except Rose, Morton who reside respectively at Brooklyn, N.Y. and California.  
(5) My last foreign residence was Minsk, Poland. I emigrated to the United States of America from London, England. My lawful entry for permanent residence in the United States was at New York, NY, under the name of SARAH GARBUS on June 1901, on the vessel Unknown.

I am not a disbeliever in or opposed to organized government or a member of or affiliated with any organization or body of persons teaching detailed in or opposed to organized government. I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy. I am attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States and well disposed to the good order and happiness of the United States. It is my intention to become a citizen of the United States and to renounce absolutely and forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to The Republic of Poland and (or) The Union of Soviet Socialist Republics of whom (which) at this time I am a subject (or citizen), and it is my intention to reside permanently in the United States. (6) I am able to speak the English language.  
(7) I have resided continuously in the United States of America for the term of 8 years at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since June 1901, and in the County of Bronx, this State, continuously next preceding the date of this petition, since June 1912, being a residence within said county of at least 6 months next preceding the date of this petition. Petition filed under Act of June 29, 1906 as amended.  
(8) I have not heretofore made petition for naturalization. No. on and such petition was denied by that Court for the following reasons and causes, to wit: and the cause of such denial has since been cured or removed.  
Attached hereto and made a part of this, my petition for naturalization, are my declaration of intention to become a citizen of the United States, and the affidavits of witnesses, and the affidavits of the two verifying witnesses required by law. Wherefore, your petitioners, pray that I may be admitted a citizen of the United States of America, and that my name be changed to SARAH MARIE SARAH GARBUS.

I, SARAH MARIE SARAH GARBUS, do sever (affirm) that I know the contents of this petition for naturalization subscribed by me, that the same are true to the best of my own knowledge, except as to matters therein stated to be alleged upon information and belief, and that as to those matters I believe them to be true, and that this petition was signed by me with my full, true name: SO HELP ME GOD.
