NAZI SENTENCED IN ATTACK

Trooper Who Beat American Landlord Gets 7-Month Term.

BERLIN, Jan. 17.—The Berlin Summary Court sentenced a Nazi storm trooper named Friedel, who beat Max Schussler, his Jewish-American landlord, formerly of New York, Monday because Mr. Schussler had dunned him for overdue rent, to seven months in prison today.

Notice of Friedel's conviction was communicated to Acting Consul General Raymond Geist by the secret political police, who, after investigating the assault on Mr. Schussler, had promised the American official a speedy conviction of the assailant.
